## BENEFITS

- Reserve and purchase your tickets before they go on sale to the public!
- Discounts: Groups of 10 (some shows 15) or more receive discounts on most performances.
  - **Broadway Shows:** The standard group discount is around 15% but varies based on show and date. There are special rates for student/senior, educator, and military groups of 10 (sometimes 15) or more for most Broadway performances. There may also be additional discounts available for groups of 40 or more.
  - **Non-Broadway Shows:** The standard group discount is around 10%.
- Deferred Payment (See deadlines below)
- Reduced Handling Charges: Groups save by paying a flat \$20 order handling charge instead of individual ticket fees.
- SEMP Discounts: These discounts are reserved for Student/Seniors, Educators and Military Professional Groups. Please mention if you qualify for this discount when booking.




