

ASSISTIVE LISTENING DEVICES



Overture Center for the Arts offers assistive listening devices for audio amplification in all performance venues. Devices and headphones may be checked out from the Information Desk in the main Rotunda Lobby.

To adjust the volume, push the up/down arrows accordingly on the main face of the receiver. The main screen will display the volume level, and, by briefly pressing the button on the top of the receiver, the battery life. ALD's will last through an entire performance.

ID's left as collateral for the assistive listening device will be safely secured at the Information Desk. The desk will be staffed prior to, during intermission and immediately following all ticketed events. Immediately after the performance, please return the listening device to the Information Desk and retrieve your identification. **Please do not return it to the coat check window.**

If you experience a problem with your device, please contact an usher immediately. If the issue cannot be resolved, equipment can be exchanged at the Information Desk.
